

The Air Cargo Agents Association of India (ACAAI)

A brief note on the Association:

- The Air Cargo Agents Association of India (ACAAI), which was found in 1970, is the premier national Association of the IATA accredited air cargo agents in India. Currently, the Association has a pan India strength of approximately 300 members, consisting primarily of air cargo agents. A few airlines, General Sales Agents (GSAs), Bonded Truckers and airport Custodians are also members of ACAAI.
- The primary objectives of ACAAI are to promote the growth of the air cargo industry in India, facilitate the ease of doing business and safeguard the interests of its members. For this purpose, the Association acts as a conduit between its Members and Ministries of Commerce, Civil Aviation, Finance, Airports Authority of India, Airport Custodians, Government Departments and Regulatory Authorities, such as Customs, CBEC, CBDT, AERA, BCAS, etc. which are concerned with the business of air cargo.
- ACAAI is affiliated to various international organizations such as International Air Transport Association (IATA), International Federation of Freight Forwarders Associations (FIATA), Federation of Asia-Pacific Air cargo Associations (FAPAA) and deals regularly with these organizations regarding issues of the airfreight industry in India and globally.
- ACAAI maintains close contacts with world bodies related to the air cargo trade, and represents matters affecting our country's air freight forwarding industry at various international fora.
- ACAAI gathers useful information about different aspects of the industry and disseminates the same to its members through regular circulars and updates. ACAAI is an invited member of various Government Committees such as the Standing Committee on Promotion of Exports by Air (Scope Air), Air Cargo Logistics Promotion Board (ACLPB), Advisory Committees of the Indian Customs such as Trade Facilitation Committee (TFC), Cargo Facilitation Committees of the Airports Authority of India (CAFAC), amongst others.
- ACAAI conducts regular training programs for its members in job-related subjects such as Basic Cargo, Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) and DGR Refresher to equip the employees to carry out their job functions professionally and competently.
- ACAAI holds an annual Convention for its members, which are held at different locations in India or overseas. This is a prestigious event in the annual calendar of its members and the trade. The Conventions are attended by ACAAI members, invited dignitaries from all

segments of the freight forwarding and logistics industries, Government Ministries and Departments, airlines, Airport Authorities, Custodians, etc. Each Convention has a theme, and the business sessions of the Convention focus on the theme. The Conventions have a judicious mix of business sessions, networking opportunities and fellowship.
