Indian Private Ports and Terminals Association (IPPTA) is registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 and with the Charity Commissioner.
- It is the vision of IPPTA to be the apex association which will play a pivotal role in the Indian Maritime Industry by facilitating the development of a modern and vibrant port sector through the promotion of private ports and terminals.
- There are at present 17 private port players /Terminals who are members of IPPTA.
